WORLD CUP SPECIAL

Regular readers may remember an initial proposal to extend licensing hours during England's World Cup matches was rejected earlier this year. Fortunately, the Beer and Pub Association lobbied hard and the decision was substituted resulting in an own goal for the Home Office and a rare away win for operators! The Government have now confirmed an automatic extension to licences for a maximum of four hours beyond England's kick off times. The last two rows can probably be ignored!

A Temporary Event Notice (TEN) is required to extend your permitted hours during any other matches. Please remember you need to apply at least two weeks in advance of any TEN. This means TEN's should be submitted very soon in time for the World Cup.
